

Overview

Keeping your truck in top working order is a primary responsibility of each driver. The best way to do this is to continue to build on your tools to successfully and safely complete a post-trip inspection.

We will cover the following:

- Securing the vehicle with an approved device before any maintenance is done
- o Daily inspections of various parts of the truck

Securing the Vehicle

How to Use Wheel Chocks

- o Check that the parking brake is set
- o Always use wheel chocks in pairs
- Place wheel chocks on the left and right wheels closest to the loading dock
- Use the right size chocks for the tire and center them against the wheel
- o Communicate with loading or unloading crew once the chocks have been securely placed

Compliance Check

New Truck Compliance Check

- o Cab card and book
- o Inspection sticker verify the truck is not overdue
- o Current IFTA stickers on both sides of the truck
- o Required permits
- License plate make sure the plates on the front and back of the truck match
- o FMCSA Safety Regulations and Hazardous Materials book
- o Paper log tickets



New Truck Safety Check

Emergency equipment

- Orange triangles in a plastic case –
 3 triangles for break downs
- Fire extinguisher charged and secured to the truck
- Extra fuses if your truck doesn't use circuit breakers, you must have spare fuses
- o First aid kit
- o LED flashlight



New Truck Safety Check

Truck Supplies

- o CB radio
- o Extra oil, coolant, and windshield washer fluid
- o Line antifreeze and diesel anti-gel
- o Chains and bungees
- o Gladhand seals
- Hammer, wrench, wire cutters, cable cutters, knife with glass-breaker
- o Shovel
- o 12 ft, 10 GA Heavy duty jumper cables
- o Tire pressure gage



Driver Safety Check List

- o Safety jacket/vest
- o Safety helmet
- o Safety glasses
- o Face mask
- o Vinyl gloves
- o Heavy duty work boots
- o Emergency whistle
- o Utility knife
- o Moist toilettes
- o Hand sanitizer
