Tips in Defensive Driving

- Look farther ahead
- Maintain a good following distance
- Leave yourself an out
- Check for blind spots
- Scan intersections before entering
- Go the appropriate speed, not the posted speed
- Avoid having to back up
- Stay alert and keep the mind engaged in driving
- Always Use Your Signal
- Maintain Your Vehicle
